 - Mountain Lion populations were raised to a candidate species after the last CDFW meeting
 - Mid-Peninsula Open Space is looking to update its grazing policy to address predator management. Public meetings were planned for the Spring but have been canceled. The policy may be updated due to the mountain lion listing. More details in future meetings

- 13. Public Affairs Updates
 - Laura attended the latest CDFW Meeting and prepared a short report for the
 - Mountain Lion Updates from CDFW Meeting:
 - CDFW has completed a 90-day study about mountain lions in CA and reviewed comments regarding the proposed listing of the species
 - Most comments were in favor of listing, although some commenters ii. against listing argue that listing mountain lions is illegal under Prop 117 as well as other State and federal ordinances
 - There are currently 6 designated populations in CA, determined by major iii. highways which fragment populations. There are an estimated 4-6k mountain lions in CA
 - Currently Mountain Lion ESU's in Southern California and the Central İ۷. Coast are now Candidate Species. The SoCal ESU's may be combined per recommendations from the Center for Biological Diversity. The Sierra Nevada population was not listed
 - SFBay TWS may contribute to the listing discussion by submitting a letter ٧. later this year
 - Laura is working with a local brewery to co-release a beer this summer that would raise funds for the Chapter
